The registration process for the Class of 2023 will be starting soon and I would like to review the process. For students from Barrington a non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 will be required upon confirmation of enrollment by Friday, February 22, 2019.

This booklet establishes academic requirements and includes a description of all courses offered at the Academy. We feel it is of the utmost importance that parents, students and the Academy work together in developing a sound academic program for each student.
