It is important to understand that mid-term and final examinations are valuable tools in measuring your achievement in a particular class. The process of taking such tests should be an essential education experience for students.

Students who have three exams on Wednesday may re-schedule one exam for Thursday or Friday, with prior approval.

If you have a semester class, you will only receive a final exam. A full year class would include a mid-year and final exam, which would be averaged together.

Students who have grades of 93 or higher for BOTH marking terms of a semester course may be excused from the final exam. (Note: This means two separate term grades of 93 or higher and not just a 93 average).

Competency remediation: Students have until the last day of classes Tuesday, December 19 to remediate any competencies. After this, teachers will submit the student's name and remediation packet with cover sheet to be made up during summer school to Mrs. Aseltine by Thursday, December 21.
