Course Description

- This course investigates various ways of linking ideas, language and theory to studio art while exploring the art elements and principles.
- Students will create, respond, present, and connect to their artworks through an understanding of the art elements, numerous artists and through their own creative presentation of their artworks.
- Students are introduced to rendering techniques for drawing and painting, basic two and three-dimensional design, photography, and color theory.
- Students will explore a complete understanding of aesthetics, art criticism, and art history while emphasizing studio production.
- Students who successfully complete Basic Art I by meeting all minimum competencies while maintaining a GPA of 85 or higher.
