2. Have 1's and 2's in effort and conduct
3. Are motivated to work hard and able to handle a vigorous workload
4. Enjoy being challenged beyond the expectations of a college prep course

3. Math placement test (this will be given in 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes for all math placement at Coe-Brown)
